The GIS Analyst is expected to perform associated job duties such as the following:

- Work with 9-1-1 Network staff on 9-1-1 related issues dealing with mapping
- Coordinates with the CBCOG 9-1-1 Addressing Coordinator on the collection of data on at least a monthly update cycle with addressing agents in the region
- Updates the mapping application via ArcMap
- Ability to understand addressing principles and guidelines
- Participates in conference calls, workshops, document reviews and other forms of communication related to 9-1-1 mapping
- Validates the GIS data quality via tools from ESRI, specialized quality control tools and reports (such as GeoComm's GIS Data Hub, etc.) to align with standards and compliance numbers set by the state and NENA (National Emergency Number Association)
- Acquires or assists in creating data to perform data management, spatial analysis, mapping, etc. using GIS tools for other CBCOG projects for the region
- Participate in staff meetings
- Flexibility to work after hours and weekends depending on project severity
- Any other duties as assigned
